**UBD Cleantech AB signs new contract with Scania AB.**

Despite that fact that the global market are entering in to recession, the Swedish remanufacturing company UBD Cleantech AB have signed a new contract with Scania AB, on supply of remanufactured water pumps.

The annual contract value is about 500.000€ and will employ 3-5 persons.

Heavy vehicle market is new for UBD, who has actively invested in product development and new additional customer strategy.

The Swedish based remanufacturing company, UBD Cleantech AB was founded 1970 and has become one of Europe's leading supplier to the car industry within the field of brake callipers, steering pumps and steering racks. The newly developed process of cleaning Diesel Particle Filters has also been launched to the European car industry, with great success.

Remanufacturing has a growing potential because of increased environmental focus from the car manufactures and the contract between UBD and Scania is a result of this new approach.

Professional remanufacturing of vital spare parts has not only a positive impact on the environment but also economical for the manufactures and car owners.

Manufacturing a brand new water pump in this size and from aluminium materiel, the carbon dioxide release is more that 15 kg per unit whilst remanufacturing only generates 0,53kg.

The alternative until now has been to replace the damaged unit with brand new parts with it's environment impact but the developed remanufacturing process allows to offer just as high functional quality with less environmental impact and lower cost.

Production and delivery is planned for April.
